

TOWN OF HELVETIA MINUTES

For September 3rd, 2024

The regular meeting of the Town Board was held at the Town Hall, and was called to order by Chairman, Jeff Oppor at 7:00 PM. All Town board members were present. 4 town residents were also in attendance.
